COACH SELECTION PROCEDURES
2008 Olympic Games
Women's Artistic
July 11, 2007

These procedures provide for selection of USA Gymnastics Coaches for 2008 Olympic Games. However, accreditation allocation is not guaranteed and the number of Coaches will be based on final USOC credential allocation and overall team size.

1. What are the NGB prerequisites for Coach positions (attach a job description, if any):

USA Gymnastics will select 1 head coach Women's Artistic. Additionally 1 assistant coach will be selected.

- i. Successful completion of USOC approved background check.
- ii. Proven team leadership
- iii. International coaching experience
- iv. Ability to communicate effectively to athletes, coaches, and judges
- v. Fulfilling the necessary criteria established by USA Gymnastics:
 - Professional member in good standing
 - Current USA Gymnastics Safety certification
 - Attend all required meetings and training camps
- vi. Must be a current National Team Coordinator or personal coach of a nominated athlete
- vii. Per FIG rules, either the Head Coach or Assistant Coach must be a female.

2. How will the NGB publicize/post the Coach position and/or application process?

The coach position will not be posted. USA Gymnastics will nominate the current National Team Coordinator and/or the personal coaches of the athletes nominated to the Olympic Team in the coach position.

3. Describe the intended method of:

- A. Identifying the pool of candidates to be considered for Coach position:
 - National Team Coordinator and/or
 - The personal coaches of the nominated Olympic Team members
- B. Selecting candidates who fit the job description for Coach
Priority in allocating Coaches credentials amongst the four USA Gymnastics disciplines will be determined by the USA Gymnastics staff based on the composition and needs of the team.

The Women's Selection Committee will recommend candidates for coaching positions from the pool described above based on the needs of the women's team.

4. Removal of a Coach:

Once a Coach Nomination is accepted by the USOC, a Coach is subject to the USOC Code of Conduct and Grievance Procedures.

5. Replacement of a Coach:

In the event that a Nominated Coach is unable to perform the duties of Coach, for injury, illness, Code of Conduct violations or any other unforeseen circumstances that would result in the need to replace him/her, the replacement candidate must meet all of the criteria listed in #1 above.

6. Which NGB group/committee will make final:

A. Recommendation of the Coach(es)?

Recommendation is made by the Women's Selection Committee to the President of USA Gymnastics.

B. Approval for the Coach(es)?

President of USA Gymnastics in conjunction with the designated Athlete Representative

7. Conflict of Interest:

Any individual who is an applicant for a Coach position and who is involved in the selection process shall recuse him or herself from any discussion or decision involving selection of the Coach.

8. Publicity/Distribution of Procedures:

The USOC approved selection procedures (complete and unaltered) will be posted/published by the NGB in the following locations and will include the USOC approval date:


